We would like to express our appreciation for the opportunity to participate in the Erasmus+ youth exchange project "Can't You SEA?" (project no. 2024-3-CY01-KA152-YOU-000288459), which took place in Pissouri, Cyprus, from 12th to 21st November 2025.

For us at Tredu Club, this was our first experience participating in a youth mobility project, both as an organization and in the role of group leaders. The project topic focused on environmental protection, sustainability, and marine pollution aligned perfectly with the core values of our NGO. The organization and support by the coordinating team were very professional, clear, and helpful throughout the process. We felt well taken care of, especially during the activity in Cyprus.

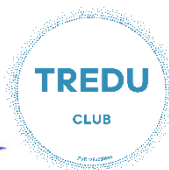
